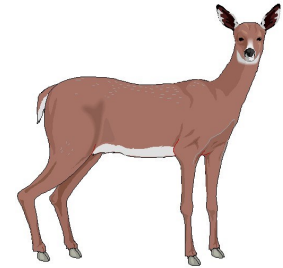

Perennials Rarely Damaged by Deer

The following plants are considered generally unattractive to deer. However some deer are hungrier than others, and some seem to have sophisticated taste. Plants with pungent fragrance or fuzzy leaves are usually least attractive to deer.
